WHO WE ARE

- DCP Midstream is a master limited partnership owned by Phillips 66 and Enbridge Inc., with headquarters in Denver, Colo.
- DCP Midstream leads the midstream segment as one of the largest producers of natural gas liquids and one of the largest natural gas processing companies in the U.S., with a value of \$11 billion
- DCP Midstream is the largest oil and gas company¹ headquartered in Denver.
- DCP Midstream also operates its wholesale propane business segment. under the name Gas Supply Resources.

OUR SCOPE

- DCP Midstream operates primarily in 16 states: Alabama, Arkansas, Colorado, Kansas, Louisiana, Maine, Massachusetts, Michigan, New Mexico, New York, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Texas, Vermont, Virginia, and Wyoming.
- The DCP Midstream enterprise owns or operates gathering and processing systems in major basins and a major wholesale propane business in the northeastern U.S. Its gathering systems and processing plants are connected to multiple interstate and intrastate natural gas pipelines.
- The DCP enterprise owns or operates 61 plants, 12 fractionating facilities and approximately 64,300 miles of NGL, gathering and transmission pipeline.*
- The DCP enterprise gathers and/or transports more than 6 trillion British thermal units per day of natural gas and produces approximately 400,000 barrels per day of NGLs.*
- DCP Midstream has 2,700 employees across the U.S.
