

## DCP Midstream Partners – Sand Hills Pipeline (Joint Venture)

### DESCRIPTION



Sand Hills was developed to meet growing demand in the Permian and Eagle Ford, where the DCP enterprise has a significant gathering and processing footprint. In the Permian, DCP Midstream, LLC is the largest producer of natural gas liquids (NGL) and has processing capacity of 1.3 billion cubic feet per day (Bcf/d). In the Eagle Ford, the Eagle Ford System owned by DCP Midstream Partners has total processing capacity of 1.2 Bcf/d.

- Business Segment: **NGL Logistics**
- Location: From the Permian and Eagle Ford to Mont Belvieu, Texas
- Scope: NGL pipeline providing takeaway service from DCP Midstream, LLC and third-party plants in the Permian and the Eagle Ford to fractionation facilities along the Texas Gulf Coast and the Mont Belvieu market hub (720-mile mainline)
- Type of Project: Organic (Dropdown from DCP Midstream in March 2014)
- Capacity: Ramp up to more than 200,000 barrels per day (Bbls/d); Expandable to 350,000 Bbls/d after completion of pump stations
- Ownership: Joint venture, owned one-third each by DCP Midstream Partners, Phillips 66 and Spectra Energy Partners
- In-service date: Began taking linefill in fourth quarter 2012, in service in June 2013
