

DCP Midstream Partners – Southern Hills Pipeline (Joint Venture)

DESCRIPTION



Southern Hills provides improved market access for growing Midcontinent natural gas liquids (NGL) production, where DCP Midstream, LLC has a leading position as a gatherer and processor with approximately 2 billion cubic feet per day (Bcf/d) of processing capacity.

- Business Segment: **NGL Logistics**
- Location: From the Midcontinent to the Texas Gulf Coast and Mont Belvieu, Texas
- Scope: NGL pipeline providing takeaway service from DCP Midstream, LLC and third-party plants in the Midcontinent to fractionation facilities along the Texas Gulf Coast and the Mont Belvieu market hub (800-mile mainline)
- Type of Project: Organic (Dropdown from DCP Midstream in March 2014)
- Capacity: Ramp up to 175,000 barrels per day (Bbls/d) after completion of pump stations
- Ownership: Joint venture, owned one-third each by DCP Midstream Partners, Phillips 66 and Spectra Energy Partners
- In-service date: Began taking linefill in first quarter 2013, in service in June 2013
